PLANT HEALTH CARE FACTS

LILAC ASH BORER

Description: 3/4 inch long clearwing moths with metallic dark brown to black abdomen and their wings and legs have yellow bands.

Host Plants: Ash and Lilac

Damage: Look for irregular entrance holes in the bark. Infested branches on mature trees typically die. Young trees may be killed by the infestation.

Control: Trees can be sprayed or injected when borers are active, usually May and June.
