PLANT HEALTH CARE FACTS

PINE WILT

Description: Needles will show light grayish-green discolorations, then turn yellow and brown. Pines over 10 years old are more susceptible to the disease.

Host Plants: Scotch, Austrian and White Pines

Damage: Death of tree within a few weeks or few months.

Control: There is still no effective way to control Pine Wilt. All that can be done is containment of the disease to slow or prevent its' infestation of other trees.
