



PLANT HEALTH CARE FACTS

RUST

Description:

1. Orange spots will develop at the point of infection, typically, the leaves of the plant.
2. Production of orange gelatinous tendrils or “fingers”
3. Spores from these “fingers” are blown to apple trees where they germinate & infect leaves, fruit and occasionally twigs.

Host Plants: Apples, Crabapple, Hawthorn & Juniper

Damage:

1. Rust lesions on fruit spots
2. Galls may form.
3. Yellowish-orange spots on leaves.
4. Early Leaf Drop

Control: The infectious period is in spring, starting at bud break. Our 3 step program protects the plant during the infection period.
